**Eligibility**

1. Three (3) year old Limited Open Class is open to any rider that has earned less than \$15,000.00 in Cat. 2 and 6 as of January 1 of the current year.
2. In Novice Stakes classes, rider or rider's immediate family must own the horse.
3. In Novice Stake classes the rider has won less than \$750 or \$1500 respectively in lifetime earnings in any reining as of January 1 of the current year.
4. A Green Reiner is a Nonpro who has not earned over \$200.00 lifetime in any reining as of January 1 of the current year.
5. A Green Horse is a horse that has not earned over \$200.00 lifetime earnings in any reining as of January 1 of the current year.
6. A Ranch Reiner is a rider who has not earned over \$50.00 lifetime earnings in any reining as of January 1 of the current year.
7. A Non Pro is a rider who has not given lessons for remuneration and has not directly nor indirectly shown, trained, or assisted in the training of a horse ridden astride for remuneration.

**Entrance Requirements**

1. Open to all breeds and grade horses.
2. All futurity horses must include a photocopy of registration papers or a vet certified proof of age
3. All cheques made payable to CCRHA. Late fees will be enforced. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
4. Incomplete entries will be contacted by collect telephone to confirm entry.
5. A vet certificate must be presented to receive a 50% refund on **ENTRY FEE ONLY.**
6. Substitution of horses will be allowed upon presentation of a vet certificate and payment of a \$50 substitution fee.
7. Change of ownership: if an entry changes ownership the entry will retain eligibility by complying with the following:
  - Notification of change of ownership and the intention of the new owner to continue entry
  - Payment of all fees
8. A rider can ride a maximum of three (3) horses in each class
9. The show committee must approve rider substitutions, in advance of the class.
10. **A one-time office charge of \$25.00 each per exhibitor & owner will apply to non-CCRHA members.**

**General Scoring and Procedures**

1. NRHA rules will apply as per the 2011 Handbook, unless otherwise specified.
2. All classes will be one go.
3. Any change in the reining pattern will be posted one hour prior to the class to which it applies.
4. Unofficial scores will be announced after each run, official scores will be posted after verification.
5. Inhumane treatment of the horses as defined by the NRHA will be grounds for disqualification as determined by the CCRHA executive. All decisions are final.

**Equipment**

1. Entries will be shown in standard headstall (brow band, split ear, shaped ear.)
2. Any horse ridden in a snaffle bit must use a smooth snaffle bit with a broken mouthpiece, minimum of 5/16 diameter. Leather curb straps only, no iron chains or other material. Reins are to be attached above the curb strap.
3. Green Reiner, Green Horse, and Ranch Reiner classes will be allowed to ride 1 or 2 handed and may use any legal bit but cannot change from 1 to 2 hands or vice versa during the pattern.

**Payout** – NRHA payback schedules will be used to payout in all classes.

**Stalls** – Box stalls are \$150 (Thurs, Fri, Sat night). All horses must have a stall.

**Payment Schedules**

1. One Payment **due** September 1, 2011
2. Entries received **after** September 1, 2011 will be subject to a late fee of double the entry fee to a maximum of \$100 per class, whichever is less.
3. Returned cheques will not be considered timely payment and if not made good prior to the deadline of September 1, 2011, the late entry penalty plus a \$20 NSF charge will apply.

Waiver – Each entrant will be required to sign the waiver.

**Rights Reserved by the CCRHA**

1. The CCRHA reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry. All decisions are final.
2. The CCRHA reserves the right to cancel, transfer, or reschedule this event without notice or liability. In the event of a cancellation all entry fees will be refunded.
3. The CCRHA reserves the right to decide any point not covered by the rules.
4. The CCRHA will retain 40% of the entry fees.

**Notice to Entrants**

1. In the case of any horse being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize shall take the prize that has been awarded to the disqualified horse and the other prizes adjusted accordingly.
2. Competitors or a Representative for that Competitor that are not present to pick up their prizes will forfeit that prize.
3. Completion of the entry form and signature of owner/exhibitor will indicate acceptance of the all the above rules and regulations.
