

Youth Scholarship

To Apply...

- The earliest that an applicant can apply for the Youth Scholarship is the calendar year in which he or she enters grade 11;
- The applicant must be less than 21 years of age on January 1st of the year that they apply for the Youth Scholarship;
- The applicant must have been a CCRHA Youth member for at least two years and have maintained a CCRHA membership up to and including the year that he or she applies for the Youth Scholarship; and
- The applicant intends to enroll in a post secondary school no later than two calendar years after the year that they apply for the Youth Scholarship.
- Must submit a reference from another CCRHA member (preferably a coach)
- Must submit a 300-word essay on the subject – How Horses have Played a Role in Your Life?

Applicants will be judged on....

- Participation in the club (number of years in the club, # of shows attended/ year, helping out in the club etc.)
- The essay
- Sportsmanship

Other information

- The money will be released to successful applicant when he/she provides proof of enrolment in post secondary school.
- Application should be mailed to the club secretary.
- The CCRHA board, excluding youth director, will make the final decision.
- CCRHA board reserves the right to determine the dollar amount and the number of Scholarships awarded in any given year.
